REQUEST DENIAL PAROLE LETTER / LAWRENCE CLAY/ ALLIANCE FOR SAFE COMMUNITIES

Lawrence Clay is no stranger to violence and committing violent crimes.

A history of domestic violence, assaults, assault with intent to murder, and assault with a dangerous weapon among several past incidents involving his uncontrollable anger.

It should have been no surprise that on October 19, 2010, Clay easily escalated to commit an unthinkable act of evil and violence.

Using his vehicle, Clay forcible kidnapped a minor in the early dark morning hours of October 29, 2009. Clay threatened to kill the female minor with a gun if she did not get into his car.

It is alleged he sexually assaulted the girl after driving around for hours as well as emotionally, psychologically, and physically abusing her.

Lawrence Clay lost his appeal in 2013 and rightfully so.

Clay has a lifetime of being a violent offender whose rage knows no boundaries, and surfaces at will.

Had this crime been committed in 2016, Lawrence Clay would not have received “goodtime credits” for committing these crimes. He would not have been eligible for early release based on those credits.

Clay’s crimes are evil and depraved. Life has taught him nothing regarding actions and consequences. He is a high risk repeat offender.

Society needs to be kept safe from the likes of a monster who engages in such violent horrific acts of crime.

Alliance for Safe Communities asks our parole board to deny Lawrence Clays ability to be paroled from Incarceration.
