## REQUEST PAROLE DENIAL LETTER ANGEL SUERO/ ALLIANCE FOR SAFE COMMUNITIES RHODE ISLAND

We tell our children “There are no such things as monsters”. We tell our children this because “in part” there really are no “fairytale” monsters dwelling amongst us. There are, however, individuals who dwell amongst us with “monstrous intentions”. Angel Suero is one such individual. Kidnapping a minor, Assault with a Dangerous Weapon, and First-degree child molestation were the charges Suero was convicted of. As presented these charges are obviously serious and deserving of the life sentence plus 20 years consecutive. One cannot fully appreciate the reason for this sentencing without a clearer image of the heinous acts Suero committed upon an innocent 12 yr old girl. Abducting and kidnapping the child at knife point off the street, Suero threatened to kill the girl if she screamed, while driving her to his apartment in Central Falls from Providence at knife point. Suero attempted to groom the young girl with pornographic videos before forcing her to unclthe article by article and lie naked on his bed. Suero raped the young girl as she helplessly lied under the weight of his body crying.

Perhaps by God’s intervention the girl was able to run and escape from the apartment under the guise of using the bathroom.

Suero is truly a monster from his core being.

A child's innocence was stolen and a life destroyed. Surely her family's lives were never the same and destroyed in many ways. There will never be parole or release from the burden and scars left on her life. Her family never to be the same.

Angel Suero will be in the prime of his life at approximately 57 years old if released following this parole reconsideration. With 1<sup>st</sup> degree arson and simple assault added to his criminal history it is obvious he is not an individual who recognizes the laws of our society. To prevent another child's life from being ravaged by this monster, Alliance for Safe Communities request the Parole Board to deny Suero's parole release. Society is not safe with Angel Suero walking amongst us.
