ALLIANCE FOR SAFE COMMUNITIES LETTER FOR DENIAL PAROLE OF JESSIE GABREAU....

What can be revealed about the violent nature of Jessie Gabreau lies simply in the history of convictions from his violent crimes.

Since 2011 Mr. Gabreau's propensity for violence emerged. Domestic assault, Resisting arrest, Disorderly Conduct, Violation of "No Contact Order" all among his repertoire.

His violence towards others even morphed into the perversive behavior and conviction of "Second Degree Child Molestation". Mr. Gabreau perhaps believing he was above the law failed to register as a sex offender leading to a further conviction.

Perhaps one of the most disturbing and violent criminal events Mr. Gabreau engaged in was in 2017, Assault of two Correctional Officers and escape.

In 2017 Gabreau blatantly disregarded his obligations during home confinement., while awaiting trial for the child molestation charges. But what followed shocks the conscious of law-abiding citizens. Having violated the terms of his home confinement and as correctional officers attempted to arrest and detain him during his "check in", Gabreau mercilessly and violently assaulted them.

Gabreau's attack hospitalized both correctional officers. Officer Joseph Gaulins suffered a huge gaping laceration to his head as Gabreau violently struck down on Gaulin's skull with the handcuffs. After Gabreau also violently assaulted officer Octeau, he ran off in escape to a convenient vehicle with friends who had brought him for "check in" at the ACI.

What we can conclude from the facts and criminal convictions during Mr. Gabreau's history of crime and incarceration, is that his violence has escalated.

Not only has he demonstrated that his violence knows no boundaries and unleashed it upon the most vulnerable, but also on those that serve and protect society.

Gabreau does not respect our laws, law enforcement, humanity, or common decency.

It is the collective criminal career of Mr. Gabreau which gives the Alliance for Safe Communities the most concern. As a habitual violent offender who only escalated over time, we feel his propensity to reoffend is great.

We request the parole board to deny Mr. Gabreau's release currently.

"No time would be a good time" for Gabreau to be reentered into a civilized society.
