LETTER REQUEST DENIAL PAROLE WALTER TRUESDALE FROM ALLIANCE FOR SAFE COMMUNITIES

What can be said about Walter Truesdale and his capacity to align with the basic prerequisites of being humane ?

Walter Truesdale lacks empathy, compassion, a sense of responsibility for actions or accountability, understanding of basic decency to a fellow human being, and total lack of conscious.

Walter Truesdale's crime of murder in the first degree was a product of his narcissistic nature and desire to satisfy his needs, wants, desires, and demands.

79 year old Irene Picard fit the profile of a typical vulnerable elderly woman. Picard who lived alone, became the most convenient target for Truesdale to target to commit larceny and murder to satisfy his drug habit.

Irene Picard had returned home to her apartment after doing her laundry, to find Truesdale ransacking and looting. Truesdale proceeded to hastily get rid of his obstacle Picard by strangling and stabbing her to death.

Truesdale's girlfriend lived across the hall , which made it a convenient location to exit to following the crime, and offered him a place to inventory his "loot" undisturbed following the murder. Later Truesdale

being the coward that he was, hid in a closet when police came to speak with his girl friend for the first time.

Truesdale was given a “life sentence” for his crimes. 28 years does not make for a life sentence. Unless remarkable progress has occurred through rehabilitation of this individual who committed such “souless “ acts, release at this time would not be an acceptable option by many in the State of Rhode Island.

Alliance for Safe Communities requests denial of parole for Walter Truesdale at this time and continuation to serve his entire life sentence for the heinous crimes he as committed.
