LETTER REQUEST DENIAL PAROLE FOR WILLIE RATHBONE FROM ALLIANCE FOR COMMUNITIES.....

Alliance for Safe Communities sends this letter regarding our concerns about Willie Rathbone's possible parole and release following the May 2026 hearing. Mr. Rathbone's recent conviction and controlling sentence was for "Mann/Deliv Controlled Substance". Mr. Rathbone's "good time" release date is set for 7/14/28. One cannot look at Mr. Rathbone's recent conviction alone to conclude parole would be the worst outcome for the sake of society and safe communities. Dating back to 2000 Mr. Rathbone's repertoire of criminal activity leaves nothing to the imagination. Sex offenses, failure to register as a S/O, obstructing a police officer, larceny, domestic disorderly conduct, robbery, possible controlled substance/sch/I-V, possession ecstasy, simple assault, and domestic vandalism, checker year after year of criminal activity.

Mr. Rathbone clearly has no regards for the laws of a civilized society and poses a real threat to its citizens. The repertoire of crimes committed by Mr. Rathbone "begs the question", "when will someone get seriously permanently hurt or worse, a life lost" as the result of one of his violent tirades?
